Compensation includes a waiver of tuition and mandatory fees, plus a monthly stipend that adheres to University minimum levels.

For the 2024-2025 academic year, the minimum academic-year stipend is \$11,500 paid over ten months. For doctoral students, the minimum academic-year stipend is \$20,000 paid over ten months. Using 2024-2025 tuition and fee rates, the tuition/fee waiver for an academic-year assistantship is valued at \$10,514 for U.S. resident graduate students and \$26,198 for nonresident/international graduate students enrolled in 9 graduate credit hours per semester. For students taking more credits, the value of this benefit is even higher. The assistantship fee waiver does not cover 100% of the supplemental insurance fee for international students on F-1, J-1, or other non-immigrant visas.
